Beloved of First United Presbyterian Church of Tarentum,

I hope this finds you safe and well as we move toward December and the completion of the year 2020. What a year it has been, one we might want to forget, yet it is one that we will always remember. Traditionally my letter has been filled with programs and activities in the life of the church. Of course, for this year, things have changed. Due to the increased number of cases and wanting to keep not only our congregation safe, but out of respect and care for our healthcare workers we will not be gathering as we have typically. That said, I want to bring some opportunities to you this day.

Kids Christmas Pageant - While this is still "in the works," we are having a virtual pageant written just for us by Rev. Ashley Birt. Shannon Wofford is taking the lead on this. Parents and grandparents, be on the lookout for more information soon on how your child/ren can participate. We will premiere the pageant via Facebook for one of our Sundays in Advent.

Christmas Eve - Weather permitting (ie. no rain) and depending on current guidance on gathering, we will be having two short outdoor worship services on Christmas Eve, each will be about 30 minutes in length. The services will be at 5pm and 7pm. We will meet outside around the front steps of the church, bundle up, bring a chair, wear a mask where we will sing some Christmas hymns, hear the story of the birth of Jesus from scripture, have a short sermon and conclude with a singing of Silent Night.

We have multiple giving opportunities to support the mission and ministry of the congregation and beyond our congregation. We are still having ongoing collections of food for the pantry and AVAC foodbank, hats, mittens, scarves and coats for the clothesline at the Tarentum Garden.
